Perceptions






- ► First Symptoms 5/2010
 - Pins and needles in tongue and lips
 - Right hand tremor
- ► GP Consultation
 - Cause of symptoms
 - Reassurance?



Symptoms





Results

- ► GP Consultation 1/2/2011
 - Urgent Neurology appointment (but for what?)
- ► Investigations 8/2/2011
 - Neurological exam
 - MRI brain scan
 - Evoked Potentials



- Lesions in the Periventricular white matter
- Lesion in brain stem
- EVP normal




Relapse

- ▶ New symptoms 25/2/2011
 - Swallowing problems
 - Facial droop
 - Loss of speech & slurred speech
 - Loss use of right arm & leg
- ▶ More investigations 3/3/2011
 - MRI brain
 - Cervical & thoracic spinal cord (lesions C7 & T1)
 - Lumbar Puncture



- Treatment 30/3/2011
 - Methylprednisolone very high dose steroids (1mg for 3 days)

 - Differential diagnosis Sarcoidosis 21/4/2011
 - Relapsing & Remitting Multiple Sclerosis 5/5/2011
- MS Nurse

 - Copaxone
 - Tysabri (natalizumab)
